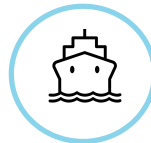
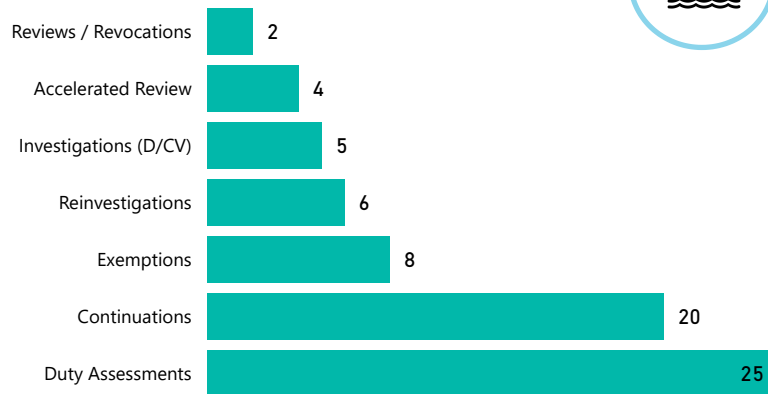

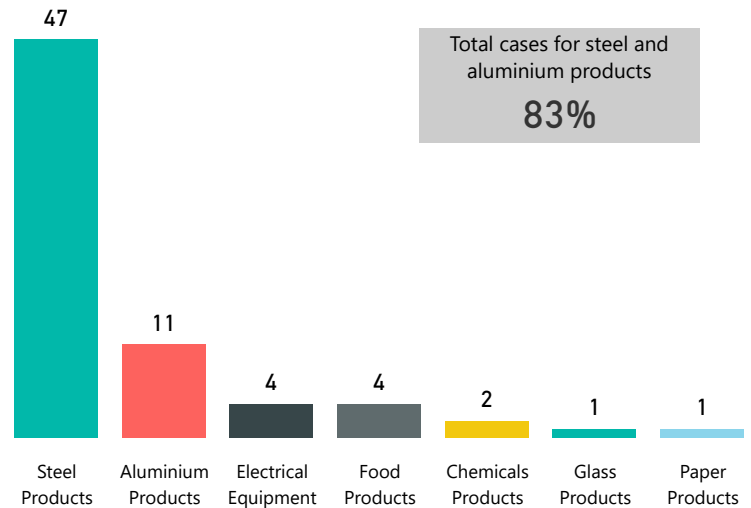

Cases on hand by investigation type



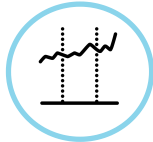
Cases on hand by industry sector



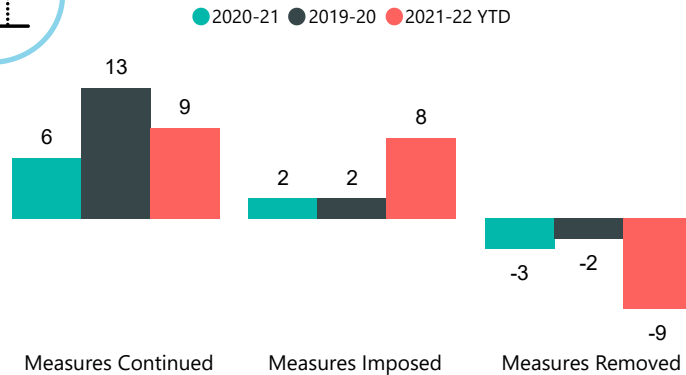
Total cases for steel and aluminium products

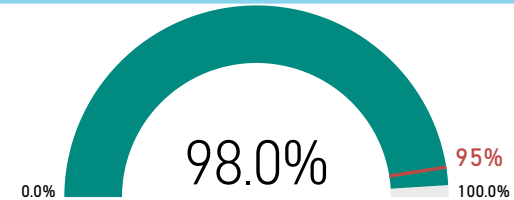

Measures imposed, continued and removed

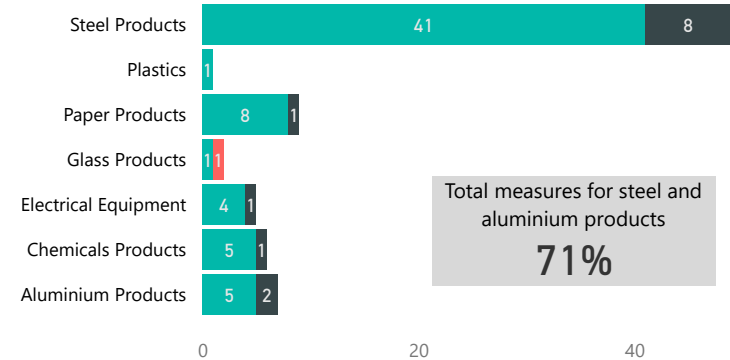

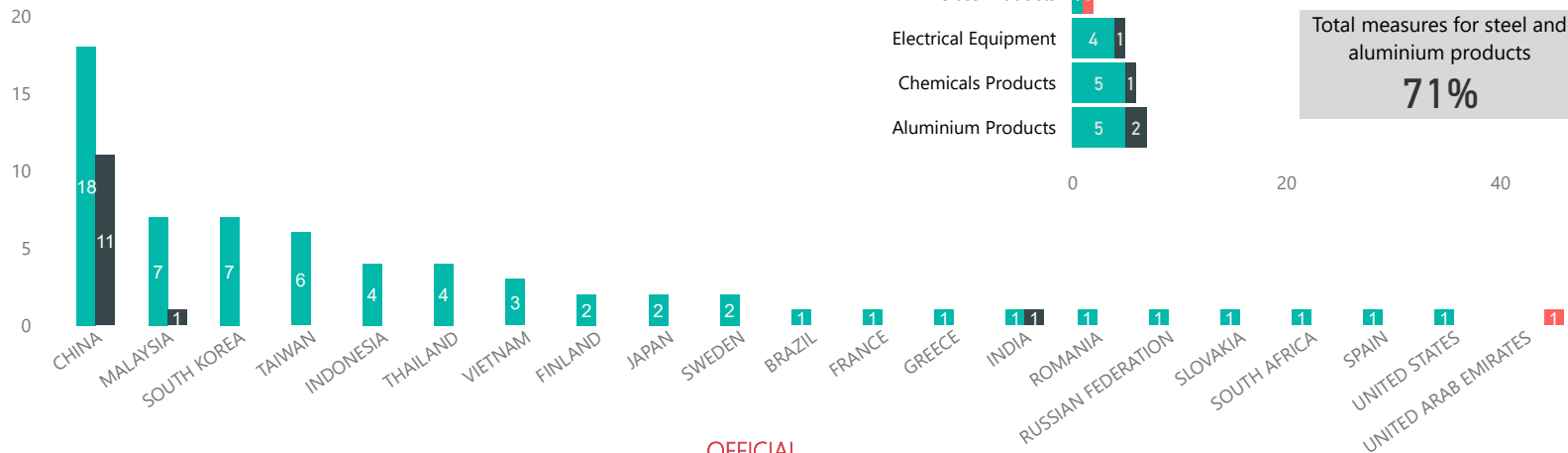
Measures by industry sector
