The Government has implemented a range of measures to increase participation in the ERF and the supply of carbon credits. This includes prioritising development of five new ERF methods in 2021 with five more prioritised for 2022, reducing administrative costs and streamlining audit requirements and a pilot to support participation from smaller projects.
