Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment for National Radioactive Waste Management Facility ("NRWMF") project near Kimba, South Australia

I refer to your correspondence of 16 February 2022 to the Board of the Gawler Ranges Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC ICN 7652 (**GRAC**).

In response, I bring to your attention my letter to Ms Sam Chard of the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science dated 2 October 2019 in which I said, on behalf of GRAC:

GRAC understands that the proposed sites of Napandee and Lyndhurst, which have been nominated as potential locations for the Facility, are within the Barngarla Determination Area. Under traditional laws and customs, the People of the Gawler Ranges do not consider it appropriate to be directly involved in this matter as GRAC respects the Barngarla people's sacred connection to their Country.

Accordingly, GRAC consider that the matter of the Facility is one for the Barngarla People and their representative body, the Barngarla Determination Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC, given that the Barngarla People are the rightful Aboriginal people who are the traditional owners of the relevant area.

For the reasons provided above, GRAC confirms that they will not be further involved with this Facility issue and trust that the Department respects their views in this regard.

I confirm that GRAC's position on this matter has not changed and accordingly on behalf of GRAC I repeat the above in response to your recent letter.

I also bring to your attention that, in reply to my letter of 2 October 2019, Ms Chard indicated as follows by letter dated 25 October 2019:

The department respects the view of the Gawler Ranges people that the Barngarla People have the sole cultural authority as the traditional owners of the area where the nominated Kimba sites are located.

As per the Gawler Ranges Aboriginal Corporation's request no further correspondence will be sent concerning the program.

GRAC acknowledges that you have sent your letter because the 35km radius you have drawn around the "Project Area", to form the "Investigation Area", happens to include two small slivers of the Gawler Ranges Determination area.

Those two slivers of the Gawler Ranges Determination area are at the outer extremities of the "Investigation Area". They appear to be more than 30km away from the actual proposed site of the NRWMF. It seems very unlikely that it would be necessary for those two slivers to be affected by the NRWMF project.

Accordingly, please exclude those slivers from the "Investigation Area". Otherwise, if they must be included, please only communicate further with GRAC if and when it is proposed that these areas may in fact be impacted by work associated with the NRWMF.
