The project will install a new roof, drainpipe, posts, and anti-condensation insulation in the clubhouse. This will improve the comfort and safety of the club for members and guests.	8,930
The project will replace the current roof which is cracked and leaking. It will benefit the community groups which use the hall by providing a safe environment.	10,000
The project will replace the carpet in the club facilities. It will benefit the community by making the club a better and more attractive place to be.	5,000
The project will refurbish the centre with new flooring and fit-for-purpose rooms. This will provide a safer environment for users of the studio and enable the organisation to extend the services they offer.	14,000
The project will construct a levelled, outdoor training area, with new seating and a pergola. This improved outdoor area will increase safety and amenity for junior and youth sailors, as well as parents, supervisors, coaches and the general public, who use the lawn regularly as a place to sit, learn and spectate.	12,000
The project will purchase a new rescue boat to service the Brooklyn area of the Hawkesbury River. This will provide the community with rescue and response services, and support river sporting activities.	17,000
The project will upgrade the window awnings and covers including for the canteen. This will enhance the use of the facilities by the local community for events and market days.	3,000
The project will upgrade the kitchen facilities, including purchasing appliances. This will facilitate community events and activities, encouraging socialisation and interaction for community members and groups.	14,000
The project will install an awning and extra stairs. This will provide cover between the school hall and toilets as well as extra seating, which will make the school more suitable for community events.	5,000
The project will add extra storage to the back of the 1st Cherrybrook Scout Group Hall. This will provide low-cost additional storage for the scouts, while improving operational safety.	8,000
The project will purchase a community bus. This will enable the organisation to provide transport to residents in Wisemans Ferry, an isolated area with an aging community that is not serviced by public transport or taxi.	10,000
The project will purchase a mower and utility vehicle. This will facilitate maintenance of grounds and recreation facilities for athletes, spectators, community members and groups.	5,000
The project will install new shelving in the Mount Colah scout hall. This will safely store and protect the equipment required for use in scout activities.	2,500
The project will renovate the Normanhurst Scout Hall. This will enable the scouts to have a safe and functioning kitchen area, teach home economics classes and facilitate use of the hall by community groups.	8,000
The project will renovate and upgrade the canteen facilities. This will increase access to facilities for community groups and create opportunities for social engagement.	4,020
The project will provide a raised storage level. This will increase the capacity of the new station to house resources and equipment, and provide space for community events.	7,000
The project will repair roof gable ends and a collapsed balcony, as well as install a storage area and a ramp. This will improve accessibility to the hall and facilitate its use for community events.	8,000

The project will install new audio equipment. This will upgrade the sound system to improve the communication during events as well as manage foot traffic in the vicinity.	2,550
The project will demolish and repair the site of the old basketball court. This will enable the space to be used for multiple sports including basketball, volleyball and soccer.	6,000



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
