The table below presents information relevant to this request. It outlines the voluntarily provided gender breakdown of entities that applied to the Industry Growth Program during the specified period, including whether applicants identified as *majority women owned* and/or *women led*. This information was provided at the applicant's discretion and was not mandatory. Applicants to the Industry Growth Program are the same as applicants to the Industry Growth Program Advisory Service.
