PsiQ Estimates messaging Dec 2025**Where is progress up to on the Brisbane quantum computer?**

PsiQuantum is working constructively with the Brisbane Airport Corporation, which is the proprietor of the site, as well as its engineering and construction partners on progressing the Brisbane facility.

Importantly, PsiQuantum has placed the order for one of the longest lead items, **the cryoplant** which will cool the system, with Linde who are now in the process of building that.

When will the MDP be submitted?

That process towards submitting the MDP is underway. Brisbane Airport Corporation (BAC) is responsible for submitting the planning application for PsiQuantum's facility.

When will the groundbreaking in Brisbane?

This project is the first of its kind and the task ahead is huge. PsiQuantum and its partners are working as efficiently as possible to break ground in Brisbane.

The MDP process is being following closely.

If pushed – 3 weeks left of this year, is it safe to say that PsiQuantum will NOT break ground in 2025 as they said they would?

That's a question for the company. **I can assure you that the company and the government want to see this project develop as fast as possible.**

The department has been receiving regular briefings, and it's understood they are working constructively with their construction partners to break ground as soon as possible.

If pushed further –

As with all infrastructure projects, this is a huge task and it is also the first of its kind. The company is working with Brisbane Airport and its partners to ensure this is done properly and efficiently.

What is being built in Chicago, why did you break ground there before in Brisbane?

In Chicago PsiQuantum is building an intermediate-scale test system.

This test system will further validate PsiQuantum's systems and architecture and will be directly evaluated by the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency's (DARPA) team of experts through the final stage of the Quantum Benchmarking Initiative (QBI) program.

PsiQuantum will then begin construction on additional phases in Chicago, and ultimately deploy a million-qubit scale, fault-tolerant quantum computer at the Chicago site, just as in Brisbane.

Will Brisbane still host the world's first utility-scale quantum computer?

Yes. The computer PsiQuantum is building in Brisbane will be the world's first commercially useful quantum computer.

Crucially, PsiQuantum has ordered the cryoplant for its Brisbane system, which is one of the longest lead-time items.

Series E Fundraising

PsiQuantum has raised AUD \$1.5b in its latest funding round, valuing the company at AUD \$10b.

The fundraising represents another important step in PsiQuantum's mission to build the world's first fault-tolerant quantum computer in Brisbane.

The funding boost highlights the strong confidence placed in PsiQuantum by leading new investors including NVIDIA and Macquarie Group, and global powerhouses Blackrock, Temasek and Baillie Gifford.

If pushed: Have the Australian and Queensland governments seen an up-tick in their investment?

Yes, the Australian and Queensland governments will have seen an increase in the value of their investment. *

For the first time in human history, PsiQuantum is building an **industrially useful quantum computer right here in Australia, in Brisbane.**

Where is progress up to on the Brisbane quantum computer?

PsiQuantum is working productively with the Brisbane Airport Corporation, which is the proprietor of the site, as well as its engineering and construction partners on progressing the Brisbane facility.

Importantly, **the cryoplant** is currently under construction in partnership with Linde.

When will the MDP be submitted?

The MDP is underway but ultimately the Brisbane Airport Corporation (BAC) is responsible for submitting the planning application for PsiQuantum's facility.

Why is it taking so long?

A Major Development Plan for a project of this kind and size has never been submitted before.

The Major Development Plan is hundreds of pages of investigations, the findings and recommendations for the site to assist in the process of getting this project off the ground.

The unprecedented nature of this project has resulted in a series of requirements needing to be met by the company and by Brisbane Airport.

Let's be clear - it's not ideal it's taking this long – but everyone involved in this process wants to get it right. And that's the most important thing.

So when will the groundbreaking take place in Brisbane?

This project is the first of its kind and the task ahead is huge. PsiQuantum and its partners are working as efficiently as possible to break ground in Brisbane.

The MDP process is being following closely. **Once that approval is given, the project will pick up at pace.**

Ground was meant to be broken in 2025 – we are now in 2026 – when will it happen?

The company and the government want to see this project develop as fast as possible.

Building a fault tolerant quantum computer has never been done anywhere in the world before, and that means issues will inevitably come up that weren't planned for - leading to unforeseen delays.

PsiQuantum has been briefing the department regularly. PsiQuantum is working with their construction partners to break ground as soon as possible.

If pushed further –

As with all infrastructure projects, this is a huge task and it is also the first of its kind. The company is working with Brisbane Airport and its partners to ensure this is done properly and efficiently.

Is the company looking at other sites?

The company has been keeping the government up to date on progress, and we want this to happen as soon as possible.

A project of this scale will always have not only a plan A, but also plan B, C, and D.

If pushed further:

PsiQuantum takes the commitment to deliver on this project very seriously - and wants to deliver on the fastest timeline possible.

What is being built in Chicago, why did you break ground there before in Brisbane?

In Chicago, PsiQuantum is first building and deploying an intermediate-scale test system.

This test system will further validate PsiQuantum's systems and architecture and will be directly evaluated by the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency's (DARPA) team of experts through the final stage of the Quantum Benchmarking Initiative (QBI) program.

PsiQuantum will then begin construction on additional phases in Chicago, and ultimately deploy a million-qubit scale, fault-tolerant quantum computer at the Chicago site, just as in Brisbane.

Will Brisbane still host the world's first utility-scale quantum computer?

Yes. The computer PsiQuantum is building in Brisbane will be the world's first commercially useful quantum computer.

Crucially, PsiQuantum has ordered the cryoplant for its Brisbane system, which is one of the longest lead-time items.

Transcript from December

Senator CHANDLER: Thank you, officials, for appearing today. I would like an update on the government's PsiQuantum contract. Ms Wilson, could you please tell us whether sod has been broken at Brisbane Airport to build the PsiQuantum computer?

Ms H Wilson : While PsiQuantum and the Brisbane Airport Corporation have made public statements regarding the planned construction timelines, the government has not. What I would not is the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications, Sport and the Arts have advised that prior to submitting a draft MDP for consideration the airport lessee company concerned is required to undertake a public comment period consistent with section 92 of the act. The Brisbane Airport Corporation has not yet commenced this public consultation period for the PsiQuantum facility development.

Senator CHANDLER: Does the department have an understanding of when Brisbane Airport will commence that public comment period?

Ms H Wilson : I might pass to my colleague Anthony McGregor.

Mr McGregor : We don't have specific dates from the company. We know that PsiQuantum is continuing to work to prepare for construction in Brisbane, including working with the Brisbane Airport Corporation, which, as the acting secretary said, is the proprietor of the site. It's engaging with engineering and construction partners, but at this stage, as the acting secretary said, until the MDP process is concluded the construction won't commence.

Senator CHANDLER: Does the department have any concerns about these lags in the timeframe for breaking ground on the quantum computer?

Ms H Wilson : Those questions really are a matter for PsiQuantum and Brisbane Airport Corporation.

Senator CHANDLER: There is federal taxpayer money at stake here, Ms Wilson. Why do you say that the delays are the airport and PsiQuantum's concern?

Ms H Wilson : Where they are up to in the processes is a matter for Brisbane Airport Corporation and for PsiQuantum. As I think I might have said in previous Senate estimates, the investment is structured to provide government financial returns, and drawdowns are subject to various conditions, milestones and project financing tests being met.

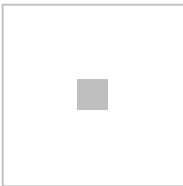

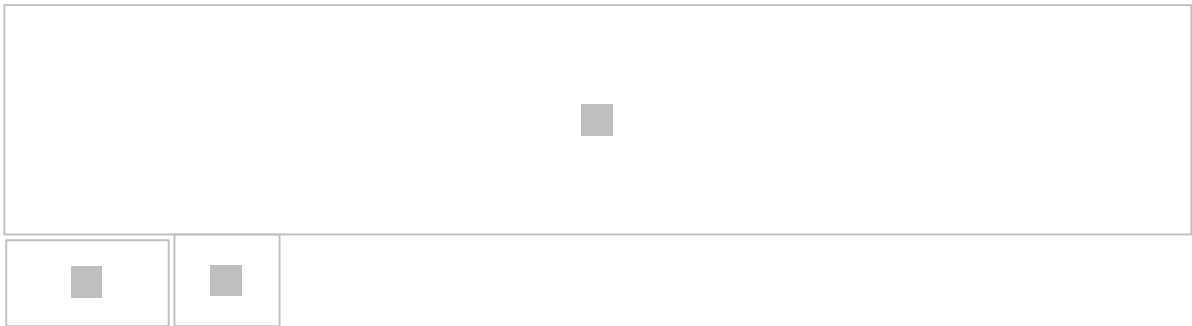
