# s 22(1)(a)(ii)

- Fortescue has advocated for changes to the Diesel Fuel Tax Credit (FTC) scheme which it thinks disincentives investment in decarbonisation or electrification. The FTC scheme provides eligible businesses with a credit equal to the tax paid on fuel used as an input when producing goods and services. Credits on eligible fuel for business activities are limited to the fuel tax revenues collected on that fuel. Taxation matters, including fuel tax settings, sit within the Treasurer's Portfolio. The Government has not announced any changes to FTC scheme.
