Re: GNSS location analysis.

Dear Sir / Madam,

At the request of Norfolk Island Regional Council, JASKO completed a survey at several locations on the bank, at the intersection of RWY 11/29 and 04/22, where a proposed GNSS facility may be constructed. These locations were then analysed to ascertain what effect any construction may have on the Obstacle Limitation surfaces that apply to each runway. To follow are the results of this analysis, and the calculated maximum height that any proposed construction can be at each site.

Discussions were also held regarding a line of trees that run parallel to New Farm Road. The height of the trees may restrict the site chosen. JASKO measured the height of this tree line, and an image of the trees is provided below.



Survey point locations.

Review RWY 04/22 (Code 2 Instrument Non-Precision Approach)**Point 1**

The ground level in this location is 4.213m higher than and 139.600m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 14.707m above ground level.

Point 2

The ground level in this location is 3.802m higher than and 127.391m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 12.676m above ground level.

Point 3

The ground level in this location is 2.323m higher than and 95.093m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 7.695m above ground level.

Point 4

The ground level in this location is 3.096m higher than and 98.377 from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 7.579m above ground level.

Review RWY 11/19 (Code 4 Instrument Non-Precision Approach)**Point 1**

The ground level in this location is 3.190m higher than and 129.190m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 4.55m above ground level.

Point 2

The ground level in this location is 2.779m higher than and 157.152m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 8.957m above ground level.

Point 3

The ground level in this location is 1.805m higher than and 176.944m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 12.758m above ground level.

Point 4

The ground level in this location is 2.532m higher than and 121.205m from the runway centreline.

- At this location the maximum height of any building / aerial can be 4.068m above ground level.

The line of trees along the road edge of New Farm Road are approximately 6m high (see image below).

Conclusion

Depending on the site location of the proposed GNSS there will be different restrictions on the final height above ground level. The transitional surfaces of the OLS effect each location slightly differently.

In summary, depending on where the site will be located, the following maximum height (above ground level) can be used for construction plans.

- Point 1 – 4.550m (based on the transitional surface of RWY 11/29)
- Point 2 – 8.957m (based on the transitional surface of RWY 11/29)
- Point 3 – 7.695m (based on the transitional surface of RWY 04/22)
- Point 4 – 4.068m (based on the transitional surface of RWY 11/29)

We hope that this information is useful and that it assists with any deliberations you may have on keeping your airport in a safe and compliant condition.

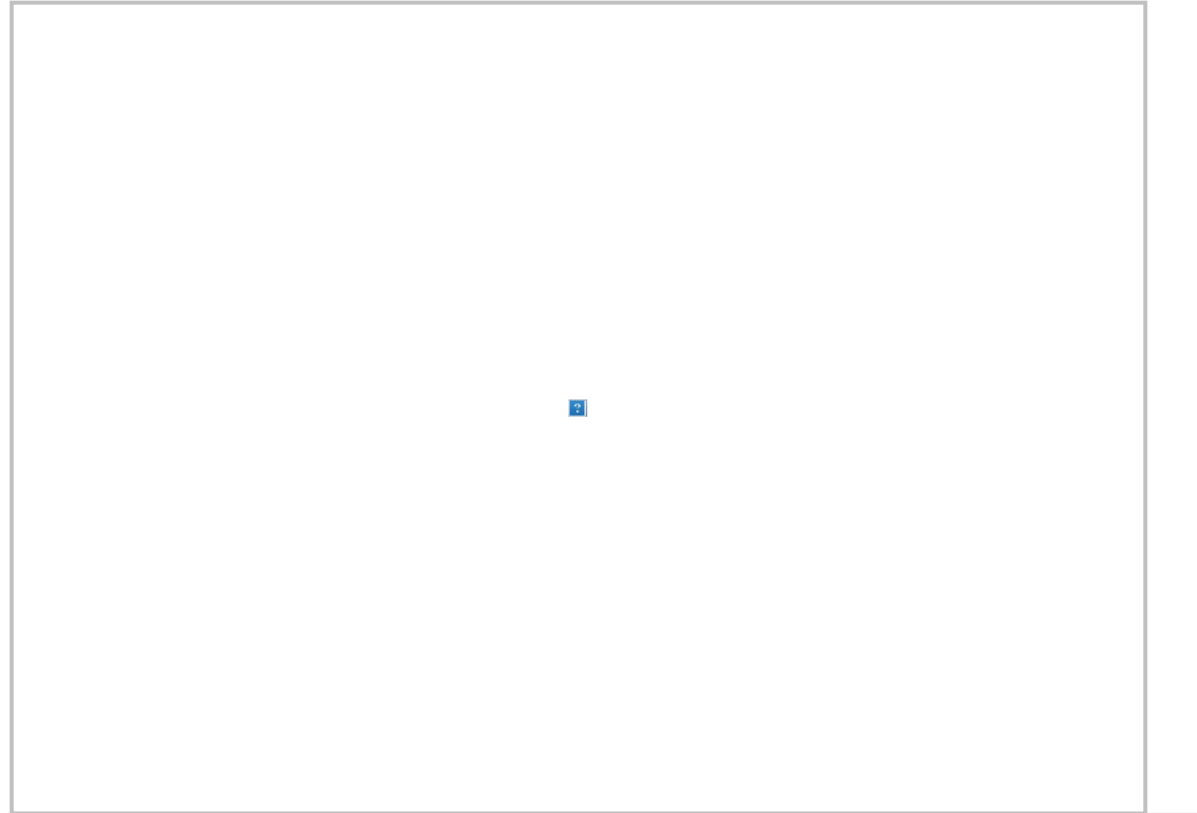

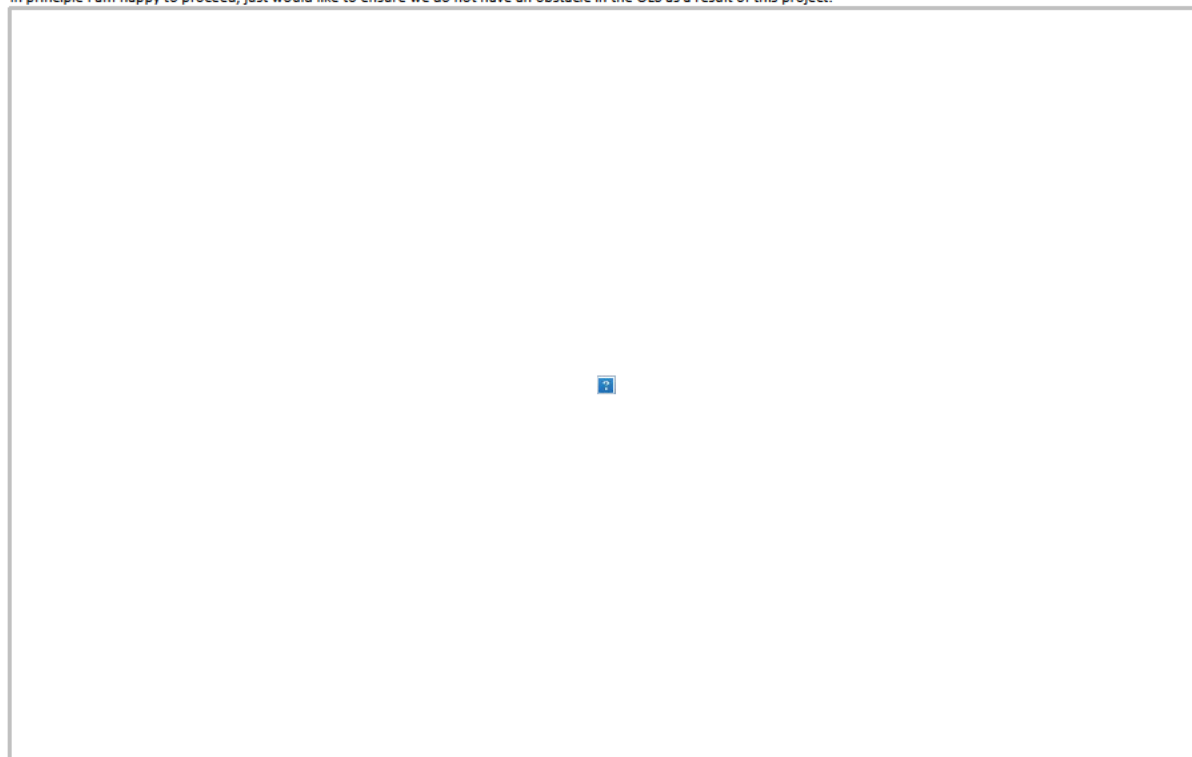

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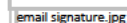

I am pleased to confirm that the SouthPAN site suitability survey performed over 14.09.2023 to 19.09.2023 deemed the proposed Norfolk Island site suitable for the establishment of a SouthPAN ground station.

This email is therefore confirmation that Geoscience Australia (Commonwealth government) wish to proceed in formalising a tenure arrangement over the parcel (~797m², approx 25m x 34m) derived from the survey (see location attached).

As I understand it the below terms were agreed and I've also included the attached email of prior communications between yourself and Ben Collett regarding the lease terms for context:

- **Lease term** as the infrastructure to be installed is required to operate for approx. 19 years, the tenure length requested is 20 yrs.

Please find attached a generic Lease Agreement for your consideration. Please note, the draft Lease Agreement is intended as a starting point for further discussion only. 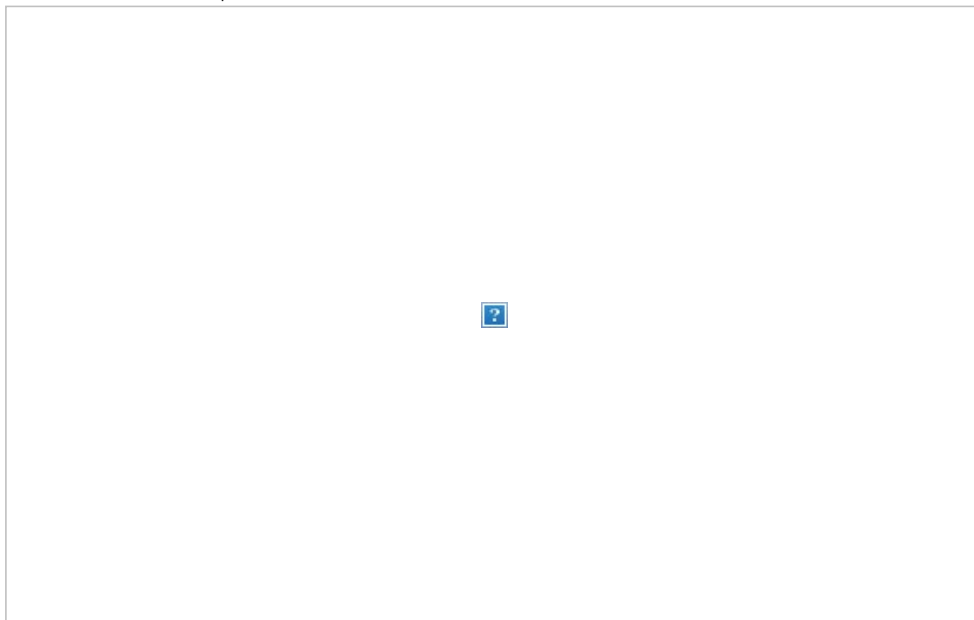

The Southern Positioning Augmentation Network (SouthPAN) is a joint initiative of the Australian and New Zealand Governments that provides Satellite-Based Augmentation System (SBAS) services for Australia and New Zealand. Geoscience Australia as the Australian Government lead agency is working in collaboration with Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand on the development, deployment, and operation of SouthPAN, the first SBAS in the Southern Hemisphere.

Geoscience Australia's SouthPAN project needs to establish a network of long-term ground-based reference stations to support this new system. We are working with local landholders, Councils, and communities to find locations for our ground stations that meet our technical needs and suit the needs of local people. The project is a major space initiative for the federal government and will require access to sites for the length of project, initially 20 years.

What is the project for?

Precise positioning from SouthPAN will offer accuracy at as little as 10 centimetres: a significant improvement on previous accuracy of 5 to 10 metres. SouthPAN provides augmented and corrected satellite navigation signals directly from the satellite rather than through a mobile phone. This allows as little as 10-centimetre level accuracy to be available everywhere, overcoming gaps in mobile, internet and radio communications.

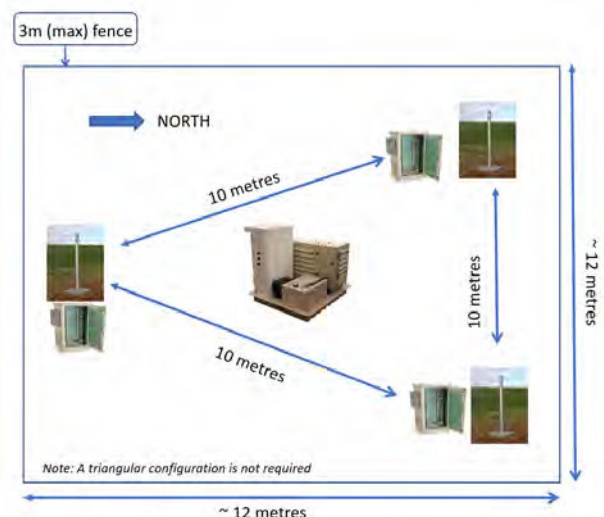
This will particularly benefit regional and remote communities as this accuracy will be available regardless of mobile phone or internet coverage.

What will the site look like?

The sizes of the ground stations will vary, depending on the outcome of the site suitability survey. They will need to cover at a minimum, an area approximately 144 metres square (12 m x 12 m). We need an area that is out in the open and not too close to power lines or mobile phone towers. Each site will have power and communications installed, and a security fence.

The fence is just to protect the equipment from damage as the Australian aviation community will use the system for navigation, and safety is our priority. The equipment is not classified.

The sites will consist of a generator with fuel tank, three antennas, and three shelter cabinets.



The site layout will be similar to this (not to scale).

Site features



Generator w/ ATS, and fuel tank

Is this safe?

The equipment will observe the satellites as they pass overhead. This data will not impact the privacy of Australians, and the sites do not put out any hazardous electro-magnetic radiation.

When is this happening?

Site suitability surveys commenced in 2023 and are being finalised now in 2024. These surveys are to measure GNSS and radio frequency interference data and don't include any installation work. The purpose is to confirm the suitability of the site before it is formally selected.

Install and operate commencing in: ~early 2025 through to 2026.

Once sites are installed, each site is expected to remain in place for around 20 years. After the initial installation, the site will need quarterly access for routine servicing. This will typically be two people with a light vehicle, and access will be by arrangement with landholders.

Geoscience Australia acknowledges Traditional Custodians of Country throughout Australia and recognises the continuing connection to lands, waters, and communities. We pay our respects to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders' cultures and to elders past, present, and emerging.

Accessing the land

Geoscience Australia staff and contractors will contact landholders individually prior to each visit and discuss land access, biosecurity measures and minimising disruption to local activities. Any concerns about environmental impacts can also be discussed.

Getting precise positioning from the system

We expect the fully operational and certified system to be in place before the end of 2027. Anybody with a device that can receive signals from a Satellite-Based Augmentation System will be able to use it and benefit from 10 cm level accuracy.

Precise positioning will benefit millions of Australians across a diverse range of industries including agriculture, construction, mining, engineering, and logistics. By enabling technological transformation, SouthPAN is paving the way for innovation and improving productivity, safety, and decision-making.

To avoid delay, the local vendors I shared can progress and liaise directly with NIRC Electrical.

Per your questions:

1) **Asbestos (Rubik's Cube/hut)**

No **as-built** records exist. Asbestos is **unknown**—the vendors provided will be able to evaluate this.

2) **Equipment in the hut**

Yes, there is **some infrastructure** remaining; none required by the Airport.

3) **Removal/return/disposal**

Dispose via **Norfolk Island Waste Management Centre**. Local vendors can arrange.

4) **Underground 3-phase supply**

Exists. Any cables **not live** and **not reserved for future use** are to be **removed**; termination points to be **confirmed on site** by your electrical contractor with NIRC Electrical. (Some termination may already have been completed.)

5) **Cables between hut, GPS antennas, mast**

Same approach: **remove** any non-live / non-retained cables; termination to be confirmed on site.

6) **Foundations/pedestals**

Above-ground removal only is sufficient. **Footings can remain in situ**.
