## **Applicant's interest**

Tipco is concerned with the exportation of the goods from Thailand.

## Details of the current anti-dumping measures

- The goods: Food Service and Industrial (FSI) pineapple.
- Tariff classification: 2008. 20.00/27/28
- Country specified: Thailand
- Date of publication of the notice: 14 October 2011

#### **Grounds for revocation**

The current anti-dumping measures are no longer warranted in relation to exports of FSI pineapple to Australia by Tipco because –

- there is no dumping by Tipco; and
- dumping is unlikely to recur if measures are revoked.

Evidence of these grounds follows:

### Exports to Australia

During the period 1 October 2011 to 30 September 2012, Tipco made shipments of FSI pineapple to Australia and at an average export price of **THB** per kg; ex-factory – details are at attachment 1.

#### Domestic sales

Tipco has made no sales of FSI into the Thai domestic market.

#### Normal value


In the absence of sales into the domestic market, it is appropriate to determine Tipco's normal value vide s269TAC(2)(c) of the Customs Act.

Tipco's normal value vide s269TAC(2)(c) for the period 1 October 2011 to 30 September 2012 is **THB** per kg; FOB ex-factory – details are at attachment 2.

### Dumping margin

Tipco's dumping margin for the period 1 October 2011 to 30 September 2012 is 2000, calculated as follows:

Normal value – ex-factory Export price – ex-factory **Dumping margin** 



# Likelihood of recurrence of dumping

It is demonstrated above that Tipco's exports to Australia are not dumped. Concerning the likelihood of recurrence of dumping, it is paramount that the dumping duty applicable to Tipco's exports is the "All Other Exporters" rate as Tipco did not participate in the investigation (review) which determined this rate. That is, it has not been determined that Tipco's exports during the period of the review leading to the imposition of dumping duty on Tipco's current exports were actually dumped.

Golden Circle Ltd, the sole Australian manufacturer, is likely to have an interest in this matter.
