Application for exemption in respect of zinc coated (galvanised) steel anti-dumping and countervailing measures (ADN 2014/16)

CMC Steel Distribution – Adelaide hereby makes a submission with regards to the Anti-Dumping Notice ADN 2014/16 issued on 26th February 2014.

Section 8 (7) (b) of the Customs Tariff Anti-Dumping Act 1975 states that 'The Minister may, by notice in writing, exempt goods from interim dumping duty and dumping duty if he or she is satisfied: that a Tariff Concession Order under Part XVA of the Customs Act 1901 in respect of the goods is in force'.

For the exemption application in question, it is a reasonable expectation that the exemption would be applicable from the operative date of the TCO as that is the date on which it has been established that there are no substitutable goods produced by the Australian industry.

CMC understands that the decision on the timing for an exemption to take effect is at the discretion of the Parliamentary Secretary and would like to emphasise the importance that this date coincides with the approved date for, TC1342243 and TC1342242, which is the 17th March 2014.
