Further to earlier correspondence, Mr. Matt Condon, Manager, Trade Development of OneSteel Australian Tube Mills Pty. Ltd., has now officially responded to my letter of 23rd December, 2013. A copy of the response is attached.

Whilst the response states that OneSteel will not object to the Exemption Request regarding the goods covered by Tariff Concession Order TC 1333313, it will object to a similar request for the goods covered by TC 1333316.

That Company has in fact, now lodged a revocation request with Customs regarding the latter Order, even though it was contacted before the original Tariff Concession application was lodged & had no objection at that stage.

Based on the response from OneSteel, notwithstanding the fact that we firmly believe that the goods described in TC 1333316 are not currently manufactured locally, I wish to advise that I therefore withdraw the Exemption Request inasmuch as it refers to goods described in TC 1333316 but continue with the application for the goods described in TC 1333313.

I understand that my client wishes to have further discussions with OneSteel re the wording of TC 1333316 but at this stage is having difficulty contacting the appropriate personnel.
