



## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2014/62**

### **Prepared or Preserved Tomatoes Exported from Italy**

### **Termination of Accelerated Review of Anti-Dumping Measures**

#### ***Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB***

On 20 June 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) initiated an accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to prepared or preserved tomatoes exported to Australia from Italy in so far as they relate to Conserve Dora SRL (Conserve Dora).

Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/49 was published to notify interested parties of the accelerated review, and is available at [www.adcommission.gov.au](http://www.adcommission.gov.au).

On 10 July 2014, Conserve Dora advised that it will not be providing information requested by the Commission as it no longer intends proceeding with the review at this stage. I am satisfied that Conserve Dora is refusing to cooperate with an aspect of the review. I have, for that reason, terminated the accelerated review in accordance with subsection 269ZE(3)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901*.
