## Exemption of certain tomato products exported from Italy

Dear Director,

This submission is made on behalf of Leo's Imports & Distributors Pty Ltd and is intended to clarify the scope and definition of the goods subject of the application for exemption from the current interim dumping duties.

As confirmed in earlier correspondence with the Anti-Dumping Commission, the goods subject of the application for exemption are:

- 1. Cherry tomatoes "Cherry tomatoes, whether peeled or unpeeled, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid, either whole or in pieces (including diced, chopped or crushed) with or without other ingredients (including vegetables, herbs or spices) in packs not exceeding 1.14 litres in volume."
- 2. Organic tomatoes "Certified organic tomatoes, whether peeled or unpeeled, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid, either whole or in pieces (including diced, chopped or crushed) with or without other ingredients (including vegetables, herbs or spices) in packs not exceeding 1.14 litres in volume."
- 3. San Marzano tomatoes "Protected denomination of origin (DOP) certified San Marzano tomatoes, whether peeled or unpeeled, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid, either whole or in pieces (including diced, chopped or crushed) with or without other ingredients (including vegetables, herbs or spices) in packs not exceeding 1.14 litres in volume."

Consistent with the description contained in SPC Ardmona Operations Limited's original application for the imposition of dumping duties, the term 'packs' used in the goods descriptions, is defined to include all container types such as cans, glass jars, pouches, Tetra packs, etc.
