



**DEEP DRAWN STAINLESS STEEL SINKS EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA
 FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

File note - Extension of time for questionnaire response

On 12 February 2018, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) initiated a review (review no. 461) of the anti-dumping measures applying to deep drawn stainless steel sinks exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China in so far as the measures affect Guangdong Yingao Kitchen Utensils Co., Ltd (Yingao).

The Commission notified Yingao that the questionnaire response in relation to review 461 was due by no later than 21 March 2018.

On 14 March 2018, the Commission received a request from Yingao for an extension of time to provide a response to the questionnaire.

Due consideration has been given to the extension request by the General Manager of the Commission, having regard to Yingao's circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extension of time given in relation to Yingao, and provides the revised due date for the questionnaire response.
