



**ALUMINIUM ZINC COATED STEEL EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA
FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

File note - Extension of time for questionnaire responses

On 8 May 2017, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) initiated two reviews (reviews no. 409 and 410) of the anti-dumping measures applying to aluminium zinc coated steel exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China in so far as the measures affect Baoshan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd and Shanghai Meishan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd (together, the applicants).

The Commission notified both applicants that the questionnaire responses in relation to reviews 409 and 410 were due by no later than 14 June 2017.

On 6 June 2017, the Commission received requests from both applicants for an extension of time to provide a response to the questionnaire.

Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by the General Manager of the Commission, having regard to both applicants' circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extension of time given in relation to each applicant and provides the revised due dates for the questionnaire responses.
