Exported to Australia from Japan, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan

Scope of Review of Anti-Dumping Measures

On 27 November 2017, I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, initiated a review of the anti-dumping measures applying to hot rolled coil (HRC) steel exported to Australia from Japan, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan (Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2017/173 refers). At the time of initiating the review, the anti-dumping measures applied to exports of HRC from all four countries.

Following the outcome of a continuation inquiry, the measures now only apply to exports of the goods from Taiwan (ADN No. 2017/166 refers). As a result, the review of measures will only consider whether the variable factors relevant to the taking of the anti-dumping measures, as they affect exporters of the goods from Taiwan, have changed.
