



## INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF HOLLOW STRUCTURAL SECTIONS EXPORTED FROM THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND

### NOTE FOR FILE – RESPONSES TO IMPORTER QUESTIONNAIRE

#### Background

On 21 July 2014, the date of initiation of the above investigation, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) wrote to all known importers of hollow structural sections (HSS) from the Kingdom of Thailand. Among these importers, the Commission identified several importers considered to be the largest importers of the goods by volume, and requested their participation in the investigation by completion of an importer questionnaire, which requested information including:

- supplier details;
- imported goods (including cost to import and sell);
- forward orders; and
- Australian sales.

The due date for responses to the importer questionnaire was set as **6 August 2014**.

#### Responses received

As of 22 August 2014, the Commission has received a response to the importer questionnaire from the following importers:

- Commercial Metals Pty. Ltd.;
- ThyssenKrupp Mannex Pty Ltd.;
- Marubeni-Itochu Steel Oceania Pty. Ltd.;
- Stencor Australia Pty. Ltd.; and
- Sanwa Pty. Ltd.

The Commission may seek to visit these importers to conduct verification of information provided in their responses to the importer questionnaire.

The Commission also requested the participation of The Trustee for Pedruco Family Trust (No 2) however; The Trustee for Pedruco Family Trust (No 2) elected not to participate in this investigation.
