



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/117

Certain preserved mushrooms exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China

Withdrawal of application for the continuation of anti-dumping measures

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 24 July 2015, I, Dale Seymour, Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, published a notice in *The Australian* newspaper announcing the initiation of an inquiry into whether the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of certain preserved mushrooms exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China) is justified.

Initiation of the continuation inquiry followed an application by Simplot Australia Pty Ltd (Simplot), claiming to represent the Australian industry. *Anti-Dumping Commission Consideration Report No. 303* sets out my decision not to reject the application and is available on the public record at www.adcommission.gov.au.

In a letter dated 23 September 2015, Simplot advised the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) that it has decided to withdraw its application for the continuation of anti-dumping measures. An application for a continuation of the anti-dumping measures must be made within 60 days of the notice advising of the expiry of the measures, as required by paragraph 269ZHB(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901*. That notice was published in *The Australian* newspaper on 30 April 2015. Accordingly, the deadline for applications for continuation of the measures was 29 June 2015.

Since no other application for the continuation of the anti-dumping measures was received within this 60 day period, I have ceased inquiries into whether the continuation of the anti-dumping measures is justified.

Cessation of this continuation inquiry means that the anti-dumping measures in relation to certain preserved mushrooms exported from China will expire on 13 January 2016, unless revoked earlier.

I am currently conducting a review into whether the anti-dumping measures should be revoked earlier than 13 January 2016. Details of revocation review no. 288 are also on the public record.
