



# **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2016/05**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

## **Certain deep drawn stainless steel sinks Exported from the People’s Republic of China Termination of an accelerated review of anti-dumping measures**

On 23 December 2015, I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner), initiated an accelerated review of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain deep drawn stainless steel sinks exported to Australia from the People’s Republic of China in so far as they relate to a new exporter, Queenswood Kitchen & Bathroom Industrial Co., Ltd. (Queenswood).

Pursuant to subsection 269ZH(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), the Commonwealth required and took securities under section 42 of the Act in respect of interim dumping duty and interim countervailing duty that may be payable on exports by Queenswood of certain deep drawn stainless steel sinks for the period of the accelerated review.

### Grounds for termination

The Commission sent an exporter questionnaire to Queenswood requesting information necessary to perform the accelerated review. The Commission actively sought a response from Queenswood with repeated contact attempts. The Commission was eventually advised by the Australian importer assisting Queenswood with its application that Queenswood would not be submitting a response.

I am satisfied that Queenswood’s failure to provide information requested by the Commission that is necessary to complete the accelerated review amounts to a refusal to cooperate with an aspect of the accelerated review. I have, for that reason, terminated the accelerated review in accordance with subsection 269ZE(3)(a) of the Act.

## Effect of the termination of the accelerated review

Termination of this accelerated review means that securities taken on deep drawn stainless steel sinks exported by Queenswood and entered for home consumption in the period 7 December 2015 to 25 February 2016 will now be converted to interim dumping duty and interim countervailing duty.

The applicable rates of duty are at the 'uncooperative and all other exporters' rates specified in the dumping and countervailing duty notices published on 26 March 2015. Future exports of deep drawn stainless steel sinks to Australia by Queenswood will also be subject to these rates of duty.
