



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2018/91

Certain Aluminium Extrusions

Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China

Withdrawal of application for an exemption from dumping and countervailing duty notices

Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

Following an application from Hills Limited (the applicant), on 5 April 2018 I initiated an exemption inquiry in relation to certain aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China that are subject to anti-dumping measures. Advice of my decision to initiate the inquiry and further details concerning the goods for which the exemption was sought were published in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2018/35, which is available on the Anti-Dumping Commission website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

On 4 June 2018, the applicant withdrew its application. Accordingly, I have ceased the exemption inquiry. No findings will be made on the exemption of the goods subject to the application.
