## INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF QUENCHED AND TEMPERED STEEL PLATE EXPORTED FROM FINLAND, JAPAN AND SWEDEN

## Extension of time for Exporter Questionnaire Responses

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) notified exporters of Quenched and Tempered steel plate that exporter questionnaires were due **14 February 2014**. During the course of the investigation, the Commission has received requests for extensions of time to the due date from certain exporters who have communicated to the Commission their intent to cooperate with the investigation.

Consistent with *Article 6.1.1* of the *Anti-Dumping Agreement*, due consideration has been given to the extension requests, taking into account the individual circumstances of each exporter and the causes which were submitted in the requests. Consequently, the Commission has granted the following extensions:
