



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2017/33

Steel Reinforcing Bar
Exported to Australia from Spain
By Compañía Española de Laminacion, S.L.
Findings in Relation to a Review of Anti-Dumping Measures
Notice under subsection 269ZDB(1) of the Customs Act 1901

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed a review, which commenced on 13 October 2016, of the anti-dumping measures applying to certain steel reinforcing bar ('rebar' or 'the goods') exported to Australia from Spain. The review was limited to examining whether the variable factors relevant to the taking of the anti-dumping measures as they affect Compañía Española de Laminacion, S.L. (Celsa Barcelona) have changed.

Recommendations resulting from that review, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the review are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 380 (REP 380)*.

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, the Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science¹ have considered REP 380 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts or law set out in REP 380.

Under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(iii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975*, that, with effect from the date of publication of this notice, the dumping duty notice currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from Spain by Celsa Barcelona is to be taken to have effect as if different variable factors (being the export price, normal value and non-injurious price) had been fixed in respect of Celsa Barcelona, relevant to the determination of duty.

The duty that has been determined is an amount worked out in accordance with the ad valorem duty method, as outlined in the table below.

Particulars of the dumping margin established for Celsa Barcelona is set out in the following table.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (www.adreviewpanel.gov.au) in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.


