## Re: Certain Aluminium Extrusions

We have read the Non-Confidential submissions by Capral Ltd for Review 248: Market Situation and Review 248: Countervailable Subsidies and were part of the original investigation 148.

We fully support the current submissions by Capral Ltd and in particular the need for duties to be more comparable to the duties in Canada and the U.S. to be effective.

The pricing of imported product has savaged Australian Manufacturers and this import pricing is only possible due to Countervailable subsidies and the intervention by the Government of China in the Aluminium Industry in China.
