Ministerial Exemption Instrument No 6 of 2017

Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science¹ have considered and accepted the recommendations of the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, the reasons for the recommendations, the material findings of fact on which the recommendations are based and the evidence relied on to support those findings in *Exemption inquiry report: EX0047* concerning certain deep drawn stainless steel sinks exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China).

Under subsections 8(7) and 10(8) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (the Act), I hereby exempt the goods described in Attachment 1 (the Goods) from:

- interim dumping duty and dumping duty, and
- interim countervailing duty and countervailing duty,

(collectively, the Duties) as I am satisfied that, in terms of paragraphs 8(7)(a) and 10(8)(a) of the Act, goods that are like or directly competitive to the Goods are not offered for sale in Australia to all purchasers on equal terms under like conditions having regard to the custom and usage of trade.

The Duties previously applying to the Goods were originally imposed following the then Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science's consideration of *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No 238* concerning the alleged dumping and subsidisation of certain deep drawn stainless steel sinks exported to Australia from China.

This instrument has effect from 11 October 2016. This instrument is subject to review and may be revoked.

In Ministerial Exemption Instrument No 6 of 2017 the Goods are described as:

Certain deep drawn stainless steel sinks, described as lipped laundry tubs used in the production of laundry cabinets that have a capacity of less than 40 litres.
