

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/83

Aluminium Extrusions

Exported from the People's Republic of China

Extension of time for decision regarding accelerated review

Customs Act 1901 - Part XVB

On 2 July 2013, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an accelerated review of the current anti-dumping measures in respect of certain aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China insofar as they relate to new exporter Guangdong Jinxiecheng Al. Manufacturing Co., Ltd.

The Commission has now completed this accelerated review and reported its findings and recommendations to the Minister for Industry (the Minister) on 23 September 2013.

Subsection 269ZG(3A) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) provides that the Minister must make a decision within 30 days after receiving the Commission's report, or if the Minister considers that there are special circumstances that prevent the decision being made within that period, such longer period as the Minister considers appropriate.

The Minister considers there are special circumstances that prevent the declaration being made within that period. These include: the complexity of issues surrounding the accelerated review, the transfer of responsibility for the anti-dumping system to the Industry portfolio and the recent appointment of the Hon Ian Macfarlane MP as the Minister on 18 September 2013. An extended period is required in order for the Minister to properly consider the findings and recommendations contained in the Commission's report.

The Minister has, under subsection 269ZG(3B) of the Act, given public notice stating that he will take such longer period as he considers appropriate in the circumstances.
