The Anti-Dumping Commission will undertake a review of the anti-dumping measures applying to processed dried currants (currants) exported to Australia from Greece after receiving a request from the Minister for Home Affairs. The review will be limited to examining whether the variable factors relevant to the taking of the anti-dumping measures have changed.

This review will be undertaken concurrently with the continuation inquiry into currants exported from Greece, which was initiated on 11 July 2013. Accordingly, exporter questionnaire responses are now due on **2 September 2013** and submissions in relation to the continuation inquiry and/or review will now be accepted until **3 September 2013**.
