



INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF ROD IN COILS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

NOTE FOR FILE – RESPONSES TO IMPORTER QUESTIONNAIRE

Background

On 12 August 2015, the date of initiation of the above investigation, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) wrote to all known importers of rod in coil (RIC) from the People's Republic of China. Among these importers, the Commission identified several importers considered to be the largest importers of the goods by volume, and requested their participation in the investigation by completion of an importer questionnaire, which requested information including:

- supplier details;
- imported goods (including cost to import and sell);
- forward orders; and
- Australian sales.

The due date for responses to the importer questionnaire has now passed.

Responses received

The Commission has received a response to the importer questionnaire from the following importers:

- Vicmesh Pty Ltd; and
- Stemcor SEA Pte Ltd represented by Stemcor Australia Pty Ltd

The Commission may seek to verify the information provided by these importers through the course of the investigation.
