



**INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED DUMPING
OF CERTAIN POLYVINYL CHLORIDE FLAT ELECTRIC CABLE
EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

NOTE FOR FILE – RESPONSES TO IMPORTER QUESTIONNAIRE

Background

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) found that there were a large number of importers of electric cable which falls under tariff classification code 8544.49.20 (statistical code 41). The certain polyvinyl chloride (PVC) flat electric cable which is the subject of this investigation (“the goods”) represent only a subset of all cable products imported under that code.

On 6 November 2014, the date of initiation of the above investigation, the Commission contacted the eight importers which each represented at least 0.5% of the total volume of all electric cables imported under tariff classification code 8544.49.20 (statistical code 41).

For those importers that indicated that they did import the goods, the Commission requested their participation in the investigation by completion of an Importer Questionnaire, which requested information as to:

- supplier details;
- imported goods (including cost to import and sell);
- forward orders; and
- Australian sales.

The due date for responses to the Importer Questionnaire was set as **16 December 2014**.

Responses received

The Commission received a partial response the Importer Questionnaire on 16 December from:

- Electra Cables (Aust) Pty Ltd

No other responses to the Importer Questionnaire were received by the due date.

The Commission granted an extension of time to Electra Cables (Aust) Pty Ltd to complete the Importer Questionnaire, which was subsequently received on 15 January 2015. The Commission may seek to visit Electra Cables (Aust) Pty Ltd to conduct verification of information provided in their response.
