



## **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/14**

### **Sodium hydrogen carbonate (sodium bicarbonate)**

### **Exported from the People's Republic of China**

### **Findings in Relation to a Revocation Review of Anti-Dumping Measures**

#### ***Public Notice under subsection 269ZDB(1) of the Customs Act 1901***

I Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) have completed the review, which commenced on 22 July 2014, of the anti-dumping measures applying to sodium bicarbonate (“the goods”) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China).

Findings and recommendations were reported to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Minister) in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 256* (REP 256). The Minister has considered REP 256 and has accepted the Commission's recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all material findings of fact or law set out in the Report.

Under subsection 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), the Minister declared that, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975*, with effect from 22 July 2014, the dumping duty notice currently applying to the goods exported to Australia from China is taken to have been revoked in relation to exporters generally.

If interim dumping duty has been paid in relation to goods exported to Australia after 22 July 2014, importers may apply for a refund of that duty. Information about how to apply can be obtained by contacting the Customs & Information Support Centre on 1300 363 263.

Notice of the Minister's decision was published in *The Australian* newspaper and the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* on 9 February 2015

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel ([www.adreviewpanel.gov.au](http://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au)) in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication in *The Australian*.
