Dear Chris and Pamela

Please find attached a letter of authority from ABB Ltd of Vietnam ("ABB Vietnam"). I would be grateful if you could direct all communications relating to ABB Vietnam to me in the first instance.

ABB Vietnam respectfully requests an extension of time to submit its Exporter Questionnaire ("EQ") response. There are a number of reasons why this extension will be necessary in order for ABB Vietnam to complete the EQ response in sufficient detail:

- Firstly, as discussed during our meeting of 16 August 2013, the product the subject of this investigation is very complex. [redacted]

- Secondly, [redacted]

- Thirdly, 2 September 2013 is National Day, which is a public holiday in Vietnam.
- Finally, due to the nature of the products, ABB Vietnam requires more time in order to fully respond to the information required for the EQ response, particularly in relation to Sections D and G. Clarification requested from the Anti-Dumping Commission ("ADC") about these requirements on Friday last has now been received and is presently being considered by ourselves and ABB Vietnam.

Accordingly, ABB Vietnam respectfully requests that the date for lodgement of the EQ be extended until 27 September 2013.

I note that it is the ADC's policy to place extension of time requests on the public file. I will prepare a non-confidential version of this email for that purpose, shortly.
