My reason for this is because the current exemption inquiry (No 23), does not specifically list our brand of tomatoes

The tomatoes we bring in are from the Agro Nocerino region which is the DOP San Marzano Region, but these particular tomatoes are not certified D.O.P to keep its cost down, these tomatoes are also not "certified" organic once again to keep the cost down

We also import them in 800gm net and 2.5kg net cans

As stated I can provide history of purchases and sales figures for this particular product
