Note for file- Ammonium nitrate exported from the Russian Federation, either directly or via Estonia

Extension of time granted for exporter response

On 09 October 2015, I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission published a notice announcing the initiation of an inquiry into whether the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of ammonium nitrate exported to Australia from the Russian Federation, either directly or via Estonia, is justified.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 112. This ADN is available on the internet at <u>www.adcommission.gov.au</u>.

The initiation notice advised that the responses to the exporter questionnaire for the continuation inquiry would be required by 19 November 2015.

Due to a request following delayed notification of the inquiry, JSC Kemerovo Azot requested an extension of the deadline for submissions.

I have, under subsection 269TC(6) of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the exporter response for this party. The party must submit the written component of the exporter (excluding tables) no later than 22 November 2015. The completed exporter questionnaire must be received by 1 December 2015.
