I have received a letter recently regarding an initiation to a review of antidumping measures from the peoples republic on China I will not go into all details regarding these measures imposed, as they seem to hurt the small type businesses like ours, yet assisting the large local and inefficient manufacturers.

We used to use local manufacturers initially several years ago until it became extremely expensive to continue doing so.

aluminium extrusions mill or polished and anodised produced locally are far below required quality and more than double the expense to purchase . when we tried discussing the subject with the local manufacturers, we were told "thats the best we can give you, if you don't like it bad luck "with this type of attitude we were forced to purchase from Overseas mainly China.

Sir, we are a small company and do not have the resources or capital to pursue the larger companies tariff reduction tactics, hence in the last few years we almost halved our imports from China on these items, but sadly the reduction was not replaced with local purchases.

Finally, I do not know if this type of submission is acceptable or not, but please note there are a number of small companies like ourselves struggling under the weight of these added expenses imposed on us called (anti-dumping & countervailing duty)
