## **ANTI- DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/15**

### **Certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the Kingdom of Thailand**

### **Further extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts**

#### ***Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB***

On 21 July 2014 I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of certain hollow structural sections (HSS) exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2014/59 which is available on the Commission's website at [www.adcommission.gov.au](http://www.adcommission.gov.au).

Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2014/125 advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 6 February 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary).

Due to the continuing heavy workload of the Commission, I requested a further extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF. This followed the Parliamentary Secretary's decision to grant an extension to the SEF deadline.

The Minister for Industry and Science has, under section 269ZH1 of the *Customs Act 1901*, further extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 9 March 2015. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will now be made in a report due on or before 22 April 2015.
