We have been appointed as an Authorized Representative for Fortune Electric Co., Ltd in the above dumping investigation, refer attached.

Fortune Electric Co., Ltd have requested for an extension to complete and lodge their Response to Exporter Questionnaire (REQ) and provide the following issues:-

- This being their first experience dealing with a dumping investigation from any country, provided challenges in understanding requirements, together with identifying and selecting external expert consultants. In addition there has been disruption to availability of staff and consultants in Taiwan due to recent Typhoon activity, which has further delayed process. Consultants have now been appointed in Taiwan and Australia to assist completing Exporter Questionnaire;
- Accounting staff availability due to half year closing;
- Complexity issues, external expert consultants have identified to date; and
- Unavailability of key Taiwanese expert consultant between 1 September to 18 September 2013, due to USA investigation.

It would be appreciated if a 4 week extension for Fortune Electric Co., Ltd to prepare and lodge their REQ to 7 October 2013, be provided. Obviously if the REQ can be completed prior to this date, it will be lodged prior.
