

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/13

Steel Reinforcing Bar

Exported from the Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Singapore, Spain, Taiwan, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Republic of Turkey Extension of time granted to issue

the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 17 October 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of steel reinforcing bar (rebar) exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea), Malaysia, Singapore, Spain, Taiwan, the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) and the Republic of Turkey (Turkey).

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/100. This ADN is available on the internet at <u>www.adcommission.gov.au</u>.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 4 February 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Minister) in relation to the application for anti-dumping measures.

Due to the large number of countries involved in the investigation, I have requested an extension of time to the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record by no later than 23 March 2015. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record.

A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before 7 May 2015.
