Object: Investigation No. 276 – Prepared or preserved tomatoes exported from Italy by Feger di Gerardo Ferraioli S.p.A. and La Doria S.p.A.

The ANICAV, Associazione Nazionale Industriali Conservas Alimentari Vegetali, is extremely disappointed about this initiation because our member companies, Feger and La Doria, were already subject to a thorough anti-dumping investigation in 2013/2014, and in that case the Australian Anti-dumping Commission terminated the procedure for the two companies excluding them from the application of any duties.

This new investigation, in our opinion, is extremely burdensome and costly for our member companies, and is based on very weak evidence and ignores almost entirely the result of the previous investigation.

For more detailed arguments we refer to the submission presented the 20th February 2015 by Feger di Gerardo Ferraioli S.p.A. and La Doria S.p.A, which we fully supports all the reasoning.

In light of the above, ANICAV respectfully requests the Commission to terminate the investigation forthwith.
