ANTI- DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2014/136

Certain Aluminium Road Wheels exported from the People's Republic of China

Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 15 September 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of a review of anti-dumping measures applying to certain aluminium road wheels exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2014/86 which is available on the Commission's website at <u>www.adcommission.gov.au</u>.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the review would be placed on the public record by 5 January 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry (the Parliamentary Secretary) in relation to the review.

Due to the continuing heavy workload of the Commission, I requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The Parliamentary Secretary has, under section 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than **30 June 2015**. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will now be made in a report due on or before **14 August 2015**.
