



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/127

Certain Hollow Structural Sections Exported from the People's Republic of China Review of Anti-Dumping Measures Relating to Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd

Extension of time granted to issue Final Report 285

Customs Act 1901 – Part XV B

On 9 April 2015 I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission announced the initiation of a review of anti-dumping measures in respect of certain hollow structural sections exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China by Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2015/51. This ADN is available on the internet at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The Statement of Essential Facts was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (Commission's) website on 28 July 2015.

On 21 August 2015 the Federal Court (the Court) handed down its judgment in the matter *Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd v Minister for Home Affairs* [2015] FCA 885, which specifically relates to the anti-dumping measures the subject of this review.

Following this judgement, I requested an extension of time from the then Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Industry and Science (the then Parliamentary Secretary) for the provision of Final Report 285 to her, so that the Court's final orders, when they are made, may be taken into account as they pertain to this review and my final recommendations.

On 9 September 2015, the then Parliamentary Secretary extended the deadline for me to provide Final Report 285 to her to the 30 October 2015.

To date, the Court's final orders have not yet been made. Consequently, I requested a further extension of time to provide Final Report 285 to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary) under subsection 269ZHI(1)(e) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act).

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under subsection 269ZHI(3) of the Act, further extended the deadline for me to provide Final Report 285 to her. Final Report 285, containing my findings and recommendations, is now due to be provided to the Parliamentary Secretary no later than 14 December 2015.
