CORRECTIONS TO COMPANY REFERENCES**

Background

On 5 November 2015, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published its Statement of Essential Facts 291 (SEF 291) in relation to the above anti-circumvention inquiry.

SEF 291 sets out the facts on which the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission proposes to base his recommendations to the Assistant Minister for Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science in relation to the inquiry.

Correction to company references in SEF 291

Since publication of SEF 291, the Commission has become aware of the fact that that document contains some incorrect references to a particular company in certain sections.

The Commission makes the following corrections:

- at Paragraph 6.1.3. any mention of Qingdao XiangXing Steel Pipe Co., Ltd (referred to as 'Qingdao XiangXing' in that paragraph) other than in footnotes relevant to that paragraph, should be read as a reference to 'Company A';
- at Paragraph 6.1.4. any mention of Qingdao XiangXing Steel Pipe Co., Ltd (referred to as 'Qingdao' in that paragraph), other than in footnotes relevant to that paragraph, should be read as a reference to 'Company C'.
