ANTI- DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2015/32

Certain Hollow Structural Sections Exported from the Kingdom of Thailand

Further extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 21 July 2014 I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of certain hollow structural sections (HSS) exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2014/59 which is available on the Commission's website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2015/15 advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 9 March 2015. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary).

To be able to conduct verification of exporters' data, I requested a further extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF under subsection 269ZHI(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act).

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under subsection 269ZHI(3) of the Act, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 28 May 2015. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will now be made in a report due on or before 13 July 2015.
