INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF WIND TOWERS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (CHINA) AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA (KOREA)

Win&P Ltd - Korea

Exporter verification visit – Preliminary findings

The Anti-Dumping Commission conducted a verification visit to Win&P Ltd, the sole exporter of wind towers from Korea during the investigation period.

Preliminary findings from the verification visit are:

- Win&P is the exporter of the goods;
- The export price for export sales from Win&P can be established under subsection 269TAB(1)(a) using the invoiced price;
- Normal values have been constructed under subsection 269TAC(2)(c);
- At this time an amount of profit to be added under the sections of the regulation has not been identified, the normal value therefore does not include an amount for profit;
- Adjustments to the normal values under s. 269TAC(9) have been made to make them fairly comparable with export prices;
- In calculating the dumping margin each export transaction was compared with the corresponding normal value;
- The weighted average product dumping margin is 16.3%
