**ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS EXPORTED THROUGH ONE OR MORE  
THIRD COUNTRIES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

**MEETING WITH ALUSHAPES ALUMINIUM**

**The Anti-Circumvention Inquiry**

The visit was conducted to provide information to Alushapes and to seek further evidence and information relating to the inquiry.

The matters discussed were as follows:

- Applicant's claims
- Potential outcome
- Evidence required
- Inquiry procedures
- Access to the public record

**The Goods and Like Goods**

- Clarification of the goods and like goods
- Clarify the range of aluminium extrusions manufactured by Alushapes

The Commission provided an introduction to the inquiry and the purpose of the visit, including the preparation of a file note for the public record and the responsibility of the Anti-Dumping Commission and its officers to maintain confidentiality in respect of information and data.

The Commission explained that the purpose of the visit is to seek evidence on circumvention and to inform Alushapes that the Commission is meeting with members of the Australian industry to seek information, conduct plant tours and to gain knowledge on market and industry practices that may be of assistance in relation to obtaining evidence from importers and exporters.

## **PUBLIC RECORD**

The Commission requested Alushapes to provide evidence or other information, including names of individuals or businesses, if it was able to do so, that may be of assistance to the inquiry.

The Commission encouraged Alushapes to pass on Mr Mäntynen contact details to any other parties that may be interested or could provide further information to assist the inquiry.

Alushapes stated that it would provide further information to the Commission if it became available to them.

Mr Mäntynen reiterated his invitation to Alushapes to provide any further information or evidence that may assist the inquiry.
