Dear Director,

With regard to the anti-circumvention inquiry on imported zinc coated (galvanised) steel from the Republic of Korea, POSCO acknowledges its receipt of the exporter questionnaire and understands the Anti-Dumping Commission's encouragement to respond to it.

However, as POSCO has already made itself clear on the circumvention suspicion raised by the Australian industry in late 2014, POSCO did not export slightly modified galvanised steel in order to circumvent its anti-dumping (AD) duty.

As a matter of fact, approximately [REDACTED] of POSCO's export galvanised steel has been already exempted from normal tariff and AD duty under Tariff Concession Order [REDACTED]

POSCO wishes this information enhances understanding of the Anti-Dumping Commission.
