



**INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED DUMPING
OF CERTAIN POLYVINYL CHLORIDE (PVC) FLAT ELECTRIC CABLE
EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

NOTE FOR FILE – EXTENSION OF TIME TO MAKE SUBMISSIONS

The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) has reviewed the submission lodged by Olex Australia Pty Ltd (Olex) and published on the public record on 4 June 2015.

The Commission understands that most of Olex's claims will be expanded upon in a further submission, but Olex also seeks an extension of time to prepare that further submission on the basis that:

- the timing of the publication of the exporter visit report for the Guilin Group did not provide Olex with an opportunity to respond prior to the completion of the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF);
- the SEF is largely based on the exporter visit report for the Guilin Group; and therefore
- Olex considers that the procedural fairness of the case has been impacted.

The Commission has considered Olex's request and has decided to provide all parties with an extra two days to make submissions in response to the SEF.

The new due date for submissions is **17 June 2015**.

As noted in the SEF, unless terminated earlier, the final report for the investigation is due by 9 July 2015.
