Jukka provided an introduction to the inquiry and the purpose of the visit, including the preparation of a file note for the public record and the responsibility of the Anti-Dumping Commission and its officers to maintain confidentiality in respect of information and data.

Jukka explained that the purpose of the visit is to seek evidence on circumvention and was meeting with members of the industry to seek information, conduct plant tours and to gain knowledge on market and industry practices that may be of assistance in relation to obtaining evidence from importers and exporters.

Jukka asked Olympic to provide evidence or other information, including names of individuals or businesses, if it was able to do so, that may be of assistance to the inquiry.

Jukka invited Olympic to pass on his details to any other parties that may be interested or could provide further information to assist the inquiry.

Olympic Aluminium Co Pty Ltd (Olympic) provided its views on evidence that may be available in support of the anti-circumvention claims, and expressed support for the inquiry on the whole. Olympic undertook to provide to the inquiry any further evidence or information it may acquire.

Olympic provided an overview of its business, its manufacturing process and its process of designing and obtaining dies. A tour of the plant was conducted.

Further discussion was conducted regarding the Australian market and the impact of imports of aluminium extrusions.

Jukka reiterated his invitation to Olympic to provide any further information or evidence that may assist the inquiry.
