



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2016/06

Certain Hollow Structural Sections Exported from the People's Republic of China Review of Anti-Dumping Measures Relating to Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd

Extension of time granted to issue Final Report 285

Customs Act 1901 – Part XV B

On 9 April 2015 I, Dale Seymour, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission announced the initiation of a review of anti-dumping measures in respect of certain hollow structural sections exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China by Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2015/51. This ADN is available on the internet at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The Statement of Essential Facts for this review was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (Commission's) website on 28 July 2015.

On 21 August 2015 the Federal Court (the Court) handed down its judgment in the matter *Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co Ltd v Minister for Home Affairs* [2015] FCA 885, which specifically relates to the anti-dumping measures the subject of this review. The Court's final orders in relation to this judgment were handed down on 27 November 2015.

The Assistant Minister for Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Industry, Innovation and Science (the Parliamentary Secretary)¹ has previously granted, on three occasions, an extension to the due date of Final Report 285. The most recent decision extended the due date of Final Report 285 to the Parliamentary Secretary to 14 January 2016.

However, I determined that the 14 January 2016 due date would not allow sufficient time to fully consider the effect of the Court's final orders on this review. Subsequently, I requested a further extension of time to provide Final Report 285 to the Parliamentary Secretary under subsection 269ZH(1)(e) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act).

The Parliamentary Secretary has, under subsection 269ZH(3) of the Act, further extended the deadline for me to provide Final Report 285 to her. Final Report 285, containing my findings and recommendations, is now due to be provided to the Parliamentary Secretary no later than 13 February 2016.²
