**REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING MEASURES NO. 392
ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA
FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

File Note – Request for Full Exporter Questionnaire Response

As outlined at Attachment A of Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2017/38, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) intends to limit the review of anti-dumping measures applying to aluminium extrusions from the People's Republic of China (China)¹, to a selected number of exporters responsible for the largest volume of exports to Australia that can reasonably be examined.² This is because the number of exporters of aluminium extrusions to Australia from China during the review period 1 January 2016 to 31 December 2016 is so large that it would not be practicable to examine the exports of all those exporters.

Having considered a residual exporter questionnaire response received from Guangdong Nanfang Aluminium Co., Ltd (Nanfang)³, which initially indicates that Nanfang exported a significant volume of aluminium extrusions to Australia during the review period, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) contacted Nanfang directly and requested a full response to the exporter questionnaire and associated spreadsheets. Nanfang's response is due by 2 June 2017.

The purpose of this file note is to advise interested parties that, although Nanfang was not an exporter initially selected for examination in ADN No. 2017/38, the Commissioner may subsequently extend the review to examine Nanfang's exports, pending among other considerations, Nanfang's cooperation with the review.
