Meeting Summary

The Commission met with ALMAX on 21 November 2017. During this meeting the Commission provided ALMAX with an update on the antic-circumvention inquiry initiated on 16 October 2017.

The visit was conducted to provide information to the Australian industry member and to seek further evidence and information pertaining to the inquiry.

Jukka provided an introduction to the inquiry and the purpose of the visit, including the preparation of a file note for the public record and the responsibility of the Anti-Dumping Commission and its officers to maintain confidentiality in respect of information and data.

Jukka explained that the purpose of the visit is to seek evidence on circumvention and was meeting with members of the industry to seek information, conduct plant tour and to gain knowledge on market and industry practices that may be of assistance in relation to obtaining evidence from importers and exporters.

ALMAX provided its views on the application and support of the anti-circumvention claims, and expressed support for the inquiry on the whole. ALMAX undertook to provide to the inquiry any further evidence or information it may acquire.

Jukka asked ALMAX to provide evidence or other information, including names of individuals or businesses, if it was able to do so, that may be of assistance to the inquiry.

ALMAX undertook to provide to the inquiry any further evidence or information it may acquire.

Jukka invited ALMAX to pass on his details to any other parties that may be interested or could provide further information to assist the inquiry.

ALMAX provided an overview of its business, its manufacturing process. A tour of their plant was conducted.

Further discussions were conducted regarding the Australian market and the impact of imports of aluminium extrusions.

Jukka reiterated his invitation to ALMAX to provide any further information or evidence that may assist the inquiry.
