Certain Aluminium Extrusions

Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China by Guangdong Jiangsheng Aluminium Co., Ltd and Guangdong Zhongya Aluminium Company Limited and the Kingdom of Thailand

Discussions with DENSO Automotive Systems Australia Pty Ltd

DENSO Automotive Systems Australia Pty Ltd (DENSO Australia) provided a response to Part A of the importer questionnaire.

The Commission met with DENSO Australia on 2 November 2017 to discuss their importation of aluminium extrusions during the investigation period from the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand).

DENSO Australia confirmed that they had imported aluminium extrusions from Thailand during the investigation period. Discussions were held on whether these imports met the goods description for the investigation.

The imported aluminium extrusions were used by DENSO Australia in the manufacture of motor vehicle components. DENSO Australia advised that, subsequent to the closure of the Australian car manufacturing industry, the nature of its imports had changed. DENSO Australia advised that it would not be importing aluminium extrusions in the future. During the meeting DENSO Australia demonstrated the nature of the goods it would be importing in the future.

The Commission also discussed with DENSO Australia the company's import volumes specified in the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) import database. Denso advised that it believed that the import volumes disclosed in the DIBP import database were incorrect.

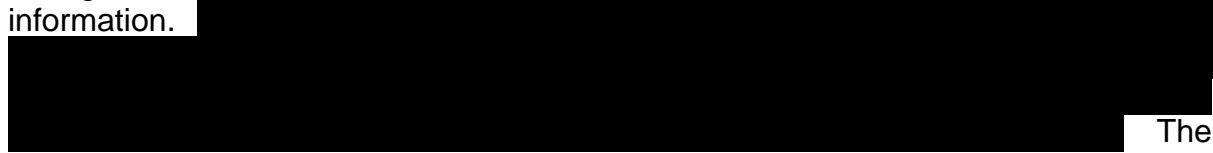
During the meeting the Commission also discussed:

- The nature of DENSO Australia's purchasing process for imported goods; and
- The nature of DENSO Australia's prior purchases from Capral Australia.

Subsequent to the meeting the Commission sought DENSO Australia to provide information to establish the correct volume of its imports of aluminium extrusions

during the investigation period. DENSO Australia subsequently provided this information.



The Commission subsequently verified DENSO Australia's corrected import volumes to source documents and technical data provided by DENSO Australia.
